- ★ The Congress, led by VP Cheney and Senator Rockefeller, is set to grant retroactive immunity from prosecution for the major telecom companies who repeatedly violated the 4th Amendment of the Bill of Rights and other civil liberties laws in exchange for a payoff of fat government contracts. This new FISA law will also have the effect of protecting the Bush Administration from the risk of disclosure in the Courts of any of their other possible related acts of law-breaking and corruption. Where do you stand on this issue?
- ★ The Congress has the sole power to raise armies and declare war. So is the hiring of mercenaries and/or subcontractor soldiers by the Executive branch either Constitutional or lawful, in your opinion?
- ★ The Fourth Amendment contained in the Bill of Rights of the US Constitution states: *The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers and effects against unreasonable searches and seizures shall not be violated, and no Warrants shall issue, but upon probable cause supported by Oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched, and the persons or things to be seized.* As President, do you pledge to uphold this provision 100% and without exception?
