- ★ You're on record favoring the appointment of "strict constructionist" judges who honor the separation of powers and respect democracy. Is this just code for your pro-life position? Or does this mean that you oppose the current Administration's unconstitutional suspension of Habeas Corpus, use of torture and rendition, warrantless surveillance, private armies, usurption of war powers, and contempt of Congress?
- ★ On your website, you've said *illegal aliens threaten our economy and undermine our culture*. Threaten our economy? – Maybe. But "undermine our culture"? We are a nation of immigrants and diverse cultures, which most Americans believe is part of our rich heritage as a country. But your statement sounds at least somewhat racist. Is that a fair interpretation of your intent?
- ★ On your website, you've said America's noble sacrifice has purchased Iraqis a precious opportunity for democratic change. It is now up to them to ensure success. Hold on a moment. We invaded Iraq as a battle in the Global War on Terror, remember? Right now, Iraqis just want electricity, water sewage treatment, jobs and security. Do the Iraqis even really care about democracy? Have you consulted with the Iraqis on this?
- ★ You went on to say: *Setting the President's November benchmark for shifting control as an actual timeline for disengagement will let regional powers and Iraqi factions cooperate to forge a new balance of power*. This would have to wait until they finish killing each other in the massive bloodbath of a civil war they're currently fighting, wouldn't it? Is this Iraq plan of yours realistic?
- ★ The Fourth Amendment contained in the Bill of Rights of the US Constitution states: *The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers and effects against unreasonable searches and seizures shall not be violated, and no Warrants shall issue, but upon probable cause supported by Oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched, and the persons or things to be seized*. As President, do you pledge to uphold this provision 100% and without exception?
- ★ The Truman commission said war profiteering is a crime. Do you agree? In your opinion, has there been any war profiteering in the Iraq campaign? By whom?
