If public schools permitted either prayer or other religious practices, should every religion and practice be given equal time and preference?
- ★ Are you in favor of "socialized" universal health care for veterans? If so, how about the rest of us, especially those who can't currently afford it on their own?
- ★ While the market-based, tax-incentivized health care proposals you have put on the table will appeal to those folks who appreciate such things, how can you convince a majority of voters that is indeed good for everybody?
- ★ If your Fair Tax proposal will reduce our tax burden, won't that mean that the government will have less money? What specific cuts do you propose to cover this gap?
- ★ You are one of two Republican candidates endorsing a domestic cap and trade program to curb greenhouse gas emissions. Will you include a cap on carbon emissions as part of a climate change action plan to be implemented within 150 days of your inauguration? How will you use the office of the President to end the partisan divides that plague the climate change issue?
- ★ You advocate free trade so long as it is fair trade. Does that mean that you'll cancel NAFTA, CAFTA, and the WTO? Are you suggesting that other countries wishing to sell in the US will have to meet American pay, benefits, environmental and workplace standards?
- ★ The Truman commission said war profiteering is a crime. Do you agree? In your opinion, has there been any war profiteering in the Iraq campaign. By whom?
- ★ Article One Section 9 of the US Constitution states that *the Writ of Habeas Corpus shall not be suspended, unless when in Cases of Rebellion or Invasion the public Safety may require it*. As President, do you pledge to uphold this provision 100% and without exception?
